- EACH SCOUT MUST BRING A BLUE CARD SIGNED BY HIS SCOUTMASTER FOR EACH MERIT BADGE
- EACH SCOUT SHOULD BRING THE CURRENT MERIT BADGE BOOK AND/OR THE INTERNET PRINTOUT FOR EACH BADGE
- EACH SCOUT MUST READ AND BE FAMILIAR WITH THE MB REQUIREMENTS BEFORE GOING TO THE CLASS
- EACH SCOUT MUST WEAR THEIR CLASS A UNIFORM & BRING REGISTRATION PRINTOUT
- A RESPONSIBLE ADULT MUST SIGN IN EACH SCOUT IN PERSON AT THE REGISTRATION TABLE

THE PURPOSE OF THE WORKSHOP IS TO INTRODUCE BADGES TO THE SCOUTS AND TO HELP THEM UNDERSTAND THE MERIT BADGE PROCESS. FOR MOST OF THE MERIT BADGES SCOUTS WILL BE ABLE TO OBTAIN A "PARTIAL" BUT WILL NOT BE ABLE TO COMPLETE THE MERIT BADGE AT THIS EVENT.

#### **MERIT BADGES OFFERED**

Each session will include an explanation of how to earn merit badge; how to approach merit badge counselors in general; and what steps are necessary at both the troop and personal level before contacting a counselor.

- Scouts will receive "partials" for the work they complete in class and they will then contact either the instructor or a Scoutmaster-assigned MB counselor in their area to finish the badge.
