Recycling Ambassador FAQs

Q: Why should I volunteer as a Recycling Ambassador?

Q: How old do I have to be to volunteer as a Recycling Ambassador?

A: Recycling Ambassador volunteers must be 14 and older.

Q: Which dates and times can I be a Recycling Ambassador at the WMPO?

A: The Recycling Ambassador schedule is broken down into 4-hour shifts, 3 shifts per day. Please see the Recycling Ambassador shift schedule below:

Q: Where can I park when I arrive for my shift?

A: Please park in the designated FREE Volunteer parking lot near West World off of the 101 at Bell Road. There will be FREE shuttles from the Volunteer parking lot to the tournament entrance where you will check in for your shift. Please allow 20 minutes to get from the parking lot to the volunteer check-in tent. The FREE shuttles will operate Wednesday through Saturday from 6:30 am to 11:00 pm; and Sunday from 6:30 am to 6:30 pm. (You will receive detailed parking info in the weeks before your shift.)

Q: What am I supposed to wear for my shift?

A: Please wear khaki bottoms (pants, shorts or skirts) and comfortable shoes. You will receive Recycling Ambassador long sleeved t-shirt and vest when you arrive for your shift.

Q: What will I be doing during my Recycling Ambassador shift?

A: Recycling Ambassadors will be stationed at or in close proximity to recycling bins and compost bins throughout the course, serving as a guide to assist fans with proper disposal of materials. Recycling Ambassadors will actively engage with fans and answer any questions they may have. You will receive Recycling Ambassador training materials via email in January and a brief training session will be conducted at the start of each shift.

Q: Will I be on my own during my shift or can I be in the same area as my friends?

A: You will be assigned a location on the course when you check in on the day of your shift. At that time, you may request to be with or near friends or fellow group members.

Q: Compost and Recycling?! Gross! Do I have to pick up or sort garbage during my shift?

A: While your primary job will be to help guide fans to put their waste materials in the correct bins, and you will not be required to sort any materials, as a Recycling Ambassador you may want to pick up a bottle dropped on the ground and put it in the recycling bin.

Q: Do I get anything for being a Recycling Ambassador?

A: For each Recycling Ambassador shift you complete, you will receive one free ticket (good for any one day) to come back and enjoy the WMPO in appreciation of your time. You will also get to keep the free gear provided on the day of your shift.
